GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS OF OCCUPANCY

Reservations - Are a contract between Sandspit Holiday Park and the person/s named on the reservation and is not transferable to any other person without the consent of management. I.e. the named person/s must occupy the site/ cabin for the duration of the contract and is ultimately responsible for all occupants. Credit card and Paywave payments are accepted and incur a 3% surcharge applies.

Check In - from 2pm for all cabins and sites

Check Out - By 10am. Late check out fee may apply.

Conduct & Noise - To ensure all guests have a great holiday, we expect common sense and consideration to be shown at all times to all people. The Management reserves the right to refuse entry and remove from the premises, any person, who in their opinion does not conduct themselves in a decent and reasonable manner. No refund will be given in such circumstances. Complete quietness must be observed from 10.30pm -7am. Electronic or musical equipment must be kept at low volume at all times.

Minimum Stays/Prices - Minimum stay and prices apply for all public holidays and long weekends and prior to Christmas to the 8th of February.

Deposits - A deposit is required to confirm your reservation. The balance of your account is payable on arrival and for the full time booked. No reduction for early departure or late arrival.

Cancellation - Payment for bookings cancelled within 10 days of arrival will be forfeited unless cabin/site can be rebooked for the full time booked. A \$20 administration fee applies. No refund for cancellations during peak times Christmas to the 8th of February and public holidays. Non arrival requires full payment. No refunds for early departure or later arrival. Damages and extra cleaning will be charged back to guest.

Visitors - Must check in at the office prior to entering the park and pay the daily fee, visitors vehicles are NOT permitted in the park, Visitor fee may apply. A visitor is a person who is not staying the night and must vacate the park by 10pm. The cabin or site holder is responsible for visitors/guests while they are in the holiday park. Visitors MUST register at the office prior to entering the park. Please note: Failure to adhere to this will see the cancellation of your cabin or site holding with IMMEDIATE effect.

Caravans/Motorhomes/Tents - Must be sited as directed by management or staff. No ropes on trees, hedges or electrical outlets/power boxes and must be confined within the marked boundaries. Drawbars must face roadways. More than one tent may occupy the site provided there is a 3 meter gap between tent/caravan on adjoining sites. Should sites be vacated prior to the reservation term, we reserve the right to reallocate the site.

Fire Safety - All tents/caravans must be placed on site to give a 3 meter gap from the adjoining sites (drawbars, ropes excluded) Fires or braziers are not permitted in camp or in the Sandspit area including the beach. Fireworks are not permitted in the camp or in the Sandspit area. Caravans/motorhomes must display a current electrical warrant of fitness and comply with LPG standard (NZ5428:2006). You must also supply your own waste water container. Please do not let waste water run onto the ground. Tents wanting to connect to power supply, must have an approved isolating transformer or RCD safety and Reyllolle plug. Our power supply is 16amps. A Maximum of 5 litres of fuel is permitted onsite and must be stored in a regulatory compliant container Please ensure all gas bottles are in current hydro-test survey. Familiarise yourselves with the camp evacuation plan. No generators allowed.

Children - Parents/caregivers are responsible for their children's safety at all times. Under 5's must be accompanied by an adult when using toilet or shower facilities.

Bikes/Scooters/Skateboards - Are not permitted between October & May for safety reasons. Outside these months, they are not permitted in or around any public areas or buildings and not after 8pm. No Motorbikes, motocross or quad bikes ridden in camp or on the beach. Playground is closed from 9pm to 7am.

Alcohol - is not permitted in any of the amenity areas or fridges. On sites or at cabins only.

Smoking/Vaping - All camp buildings/amenities are smoke and vape free

Kitchen - is to be used as intended. Benches are not for sitting or sleeping/ relaxing on and is not a recreation room.

Rubbish - Please help us to achieve our environmental targets by using the appropriate bins for refuse. Only domestic table waste in the main bin and general table waste recycling in the recycling bins. NO large items I.e. Gazebo frames, awnings, tables, chairs, tent poles, furniture etc - These are to be removed by yourselves. Please flatten all boxes and place in cage for paper and cardboard.

Water - Water supply is from a bore and is metered, thus NO wastage please. Water bombs /balloons are prohibited for safety reasons. Water pistols not to be filled, or used, inside amenity block or camp buildings.

Animals - Campers or visitors are not permitted to have animals or pets in the holiday park, in or out of vehicles at any time. There are a small number of pet friendly campsites available during the off season (May to October and not during any public holiday periods) but not in any cabins or units.

Vehicles/Parking - Only one (1) vehicle per site or cabin is permitted. NO PARKING on or in front of empty sites or driveways. Extra vehicles must be parked outside the park entrance. NO VISITORS VEHICLES permitted in the park.

Speed Limit - is WALKING PACE ONLY, watch for children. Pedestrians have right of way. Speed or dangerous driving could result in your vehicle being denied entry.

Boats & Trailers - Must be parked in the designated boat parking areas as directed by management or staff. No boats or trailers are permitted on sites or near cabins for safety reasons. There is luggage trailer parking available, please see the office.

Boat Launching/Retrieving - Boats may NOT be launched by vehicle from within camp. There is paid launching at the Marina or free launching at the local wharf at the end of Sandspit Road.

Property Damage - Park Management shall not be held responsible for the loss, theft or damage of any property for any reason, regardless of the cause, including any fault pertaining to any fitting, applicant, or piece of apparatus within the vicinity of the park.

Emergency - For police, Fire or Ambulance dial 111

Office Hours - 9am to 6pm unless otherwise stated or pre-arranged and usually during peak times between October & May. If the office is unattended in these hours please ring the number posted on the office door for assistance.

After Hours Emergencies - There will be a mobile number posted on the front door of the office for the after-hours emergency duty person. Any call out deemed not to be an emergency will incur a call out fee.

CAMP FACILITIES AND ACTIVITIES

Kayaks - Free kayaks are available for the kids on the beachfront. Life jackets must be worn and are available with the kayaks. The kayaks will be unlocked 2 hours prior to high tide and locked up again 2 hours after high tide. Paddle boards are available from the office during office hours with a bond that is returned when the gear is returned and in its same condition.

Trampoline - is free for anyone staying in the park and is located in front of the office. Please only 1 at a time for safety reasons.

Giant Art Trail - is located behind the park on the track leading to the walking track. There are 6 pieces to find with the first to the left of the black tanks and the last just after you enter the bush track.

Movie Hall - Available during summer at specified screen times, to be advised

DVD's - A list is available from the office during office hours and are free to borrow.

Table-Tennis - There is a concrete table located by the BBQ area. Good Bats (require a bond) and balls for \$1 each are available at the office during office hours.

Croquet & Pétanque - Sets are available from the office during office hours, Please return after use.

Playgrounds - There is a small kids playground located by the BBQ area, cook your dinner while watching your kids or there is a new large playground located directly opposite the holiday park.

Camp Walks - Take the road up the hill. The road will lead you to the 200yr old Pohutukawa tree. Walk in under it. Back track to the mown grassed area and follow the track through native bush. Tracks do lead off the main track up to Brick Bay but they are steeper. Keeping to the main track will bring you out at a lovely grassed area where you walk back along the beach. Best done when the tide is out. A flat walk for those that don't like hills. Go out the camp entrance, cross the road then walk towards the boat club until you see the boardwalk. Follow it down to the main wharf. Or a walk round to Snells beach at low tide. Takes about one hour one way.

Camp Library - Free for campers while staying or leave one take one. Located at the end of the movie hall. Opening hours 9am-6pm

Internet - Zenbu wireless is available with many different plan options. Log on yourself or purchase vouchers from the office. Search in your wireless and connect to the Zenbu Hotspot - Sandspit, Log in with your email address and receive 100mb for free or if you are wanting to stream Tv or download large amounts of data you will need to buy a plan.

Camp Laundry - There are 3 washers and 2 dryers located in the Laundry block. They are 2 x \$2 for a wash and 2 x \$2 for a dry. There is washing powder and coins available during office hours in the office. Cold wash only.
